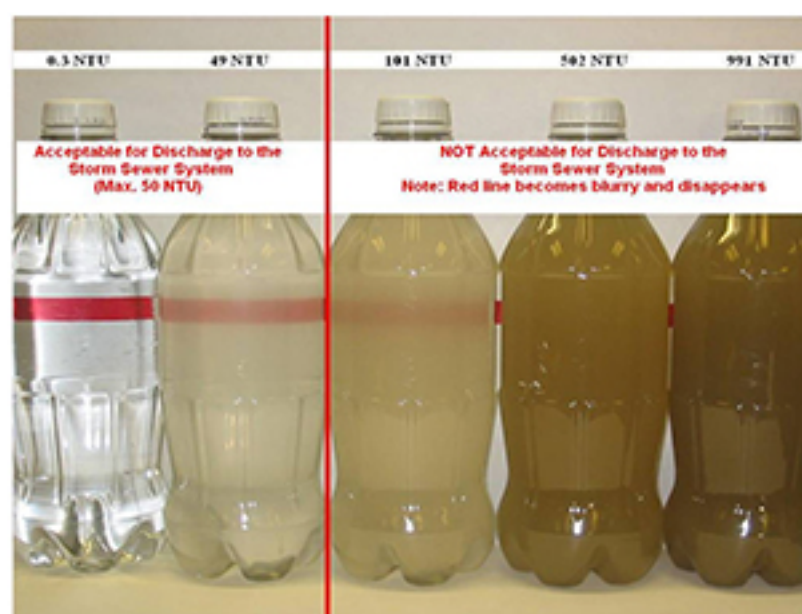


Drainage permit requirements

Please note: Starting from July 2, 2015 the Drainage Permit Application process will be amended. Below are the documents supporting the updated process that you'll be required to follow starting from July 2, 2015.

Under the [PDF Drainage Bylaw](#), no person should discharge, release or cause to be placed any substance other than storm drainage into a Storm Drainage Collection System unless they are authorized to do so, in writing, by the Director of Water Resources or the release is authorized under a City of Calgary Bylaw.

Turbidity Examples

- Use the [PDF Site Drainage Self Assessment and Application](#) form to determine what type of site you have, and to apply for a Drainage Notification or Approval.
- When you are ready to begin pumping, submit the [PDF Drainage Commencement Notice](#) two days before you start.
- While pumping, use the [PDF Inspection Documentation Table](#) to track and document inspection results.
- When you have finished pumping, submit the [PDF Drainage Completion Notice](#) within two days of finishing pumping.
